Policy: For the duration of the CoVid-19 crisis, MA DPH has issued an emergency waiver of certain provisions of the Emergency Medical Services (EMS) System Regulations, 105 CMR 170.000 in order to alleviate hospital emergency department overcrowding and reduce the spread of infectious disease due to COVID-19, by allowing EMS to bring patients in impending childbirth, or with pregnancy complications, by ambulance directly to a labor and delivery department, or other alternate site designated by the hospital on its grounds for such patients, instead of to the hospital's emergency department.

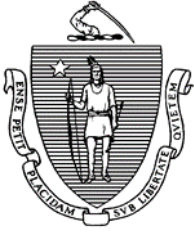
Scope: EMS transport to NSMC direct to BirthPlace with patients who:

1. Who do NOT have signs of Respiratory Distress
AND Either:
2. Are status post Extramural (Field) Birth
OR
3. Are \geq 22 weeks gestation with Primary Obstetric Complaints

Procedures:

1. EMS identifies a patient that fits the above criteria.
2. EMS provides entry note to ED as per current process.
3. ED Staffer receiving entry note directs crew to Birthplace
4. ED Staffer receiving entry note forwards pre-entry information to BirthPlace at x1945 or x3340.
5. EMS bring patient directly to BirthPlace entrance.

TO: All Licensed Ambulance Services

RE: Waiver for EMS Transport of Emergency Patients in Impending Childbirth or with Pregnancy Complications to Designated Alternate Sites on Hospital Grounds
DATE: April 3, 2020

The Massachusetts Department of Public Health (DPH) continues to work with federal, state and local partners on the outbreak of novel Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19), caused by the virus SARS-CoV-2, and we continue to appreciate the essential role you have in responding to this evolving situation.

Pursuant to the Commissioner of Public Health's authority under G.L. c. 111C, §22, and for the length of the COVID-19 public health emergency, certain provisions of the Emergency Medical Services (EMS) System Regulations, 105 CMR 170.000, have been suspended through this waiver.

The purpose of this waiver is to alleviate hospital emergency department overcrowding and reduce the spread of infectious disease due to COVID-19, by allowing EMS to bring patients in impending childbirth, or with pregnancy complications, by ambulance directly to a labor and delivery department, or other alternate site designated by the hospital on its grounds for such patients, instead of to the hospital's emergency department.

Term of the Suspension:

This order shall be effective:

From: Immediate
To: Termination of the COVID-19 State of Emergency

Effective section: 105 CMR 170.020 Definitions

"Appropriate Health Care Facility" shall mean:

An emergency department, either physically located within an acute care hospital license by the Department pursuant to 105 CMR 130.000 to provide emergency services, or in a satellite emergency facility approved by the Department pursuant to 130.821, or an alternate site on the hospital's grounds, designated by the acute care hospital, for the reception of emergency patients in impending childbirth or pregnancy complications, that is closest geographically or conforms to a Department-approved point of entry plan.
